



2026-2027 TESTING OPTIONS

St. John's requires one admission test for Classes 5-11 called the ISEE (Independent School Entrance Exam). Parents/guardians are asked to send these scores directly to St. John's School (from the ERB website) by the deadline of **Friday, January 9, 2026**. Please use the school code **443425** when submitting these results.

There are several ways that the ISEE testing can be completed, and students may take this test up to two times during the admission season (once from August to November and again December to January). Most importantly, we request that you submit only **ONE** of these tests.

The various options for completion of this test include:

- At-Home
- At-School
- In-Office
- Prometric

The cost of the test may vary depending on the method chosen, and you will want to pay careful attention, as to avoid any late registration fees. St. John's will host ISEE paper and pencil testing on the following dates:

- **Classes 7-12: Saturday, November 15, 2025 @ 8:30 a.m.**
- **Classes 5-6: Saturday, December 6, 2025 @ 8:30 a.m.**

Applicants do not need to take the test at St. John's. When registering, please select an option and date that is convenient for you and your family.

Preparation for this exam (for Classes 5-12) is acceptable. Please know that we do not super score or consult with families regarding scores.
