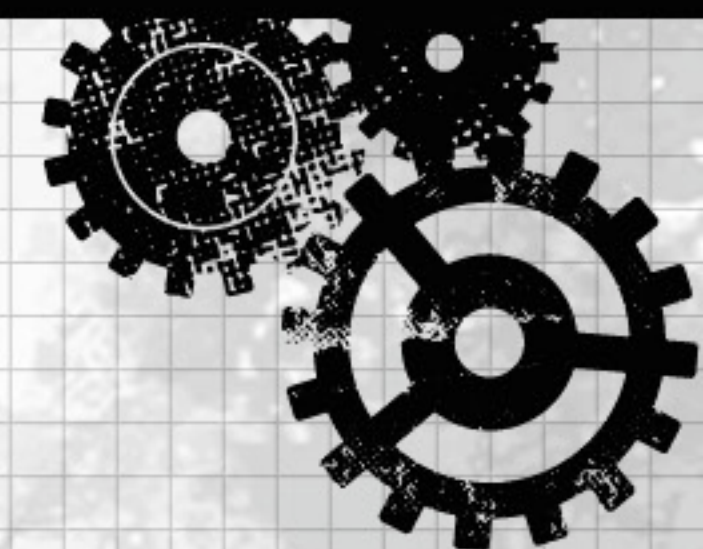

Please run Launcher.exe to start the game. The launcher program allows you to set the screen size at start, and assign keys to your gamepad.

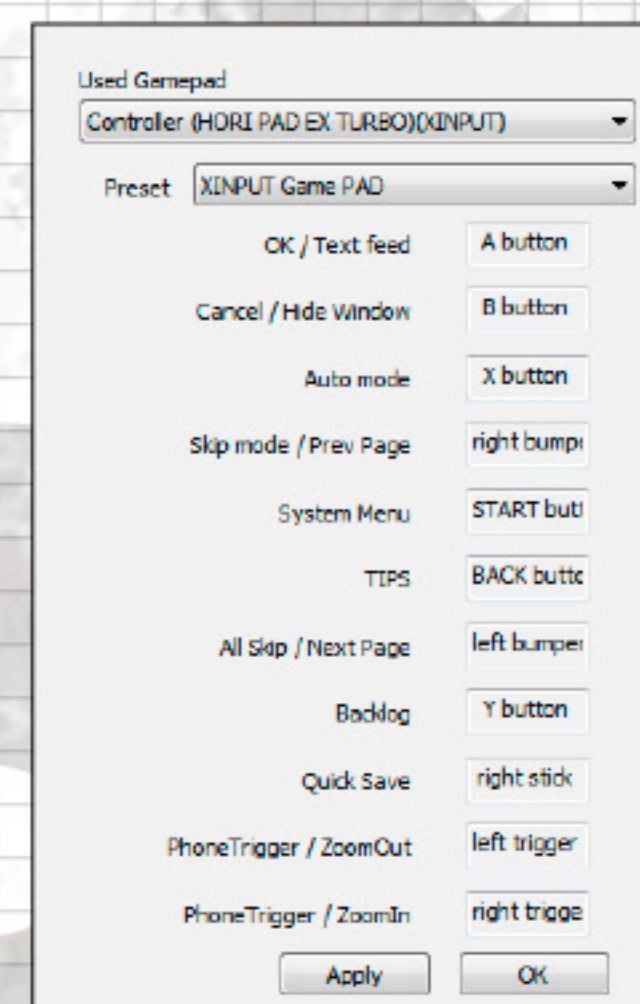
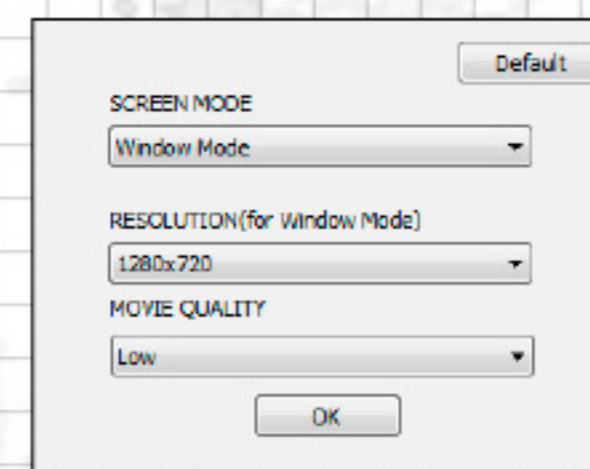
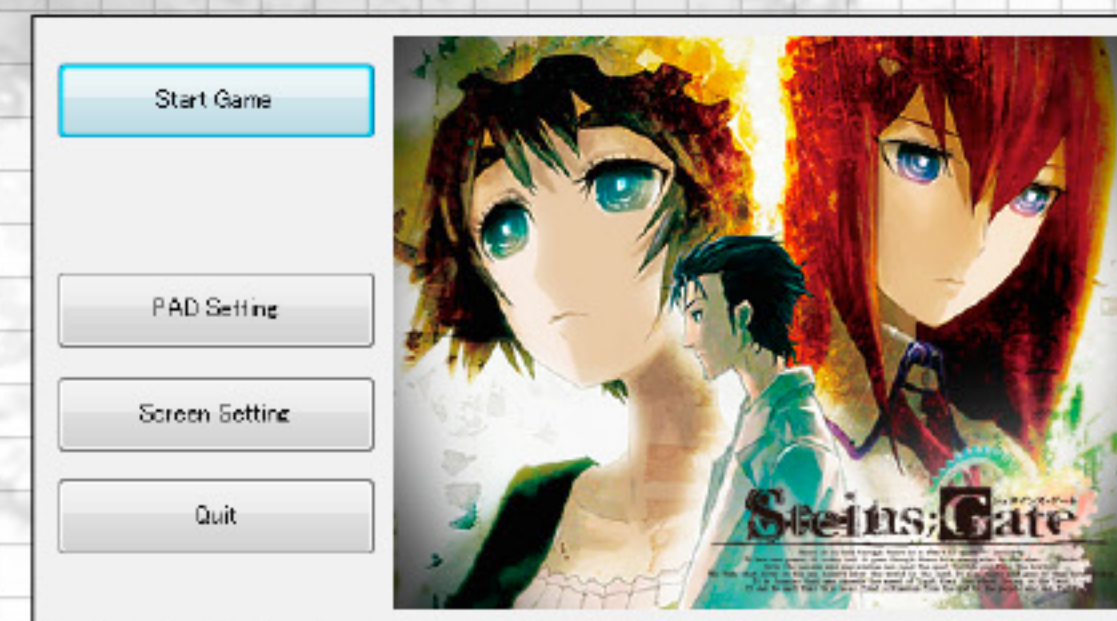
Display Settings

Allows you to change the screen resolution and movie quality.

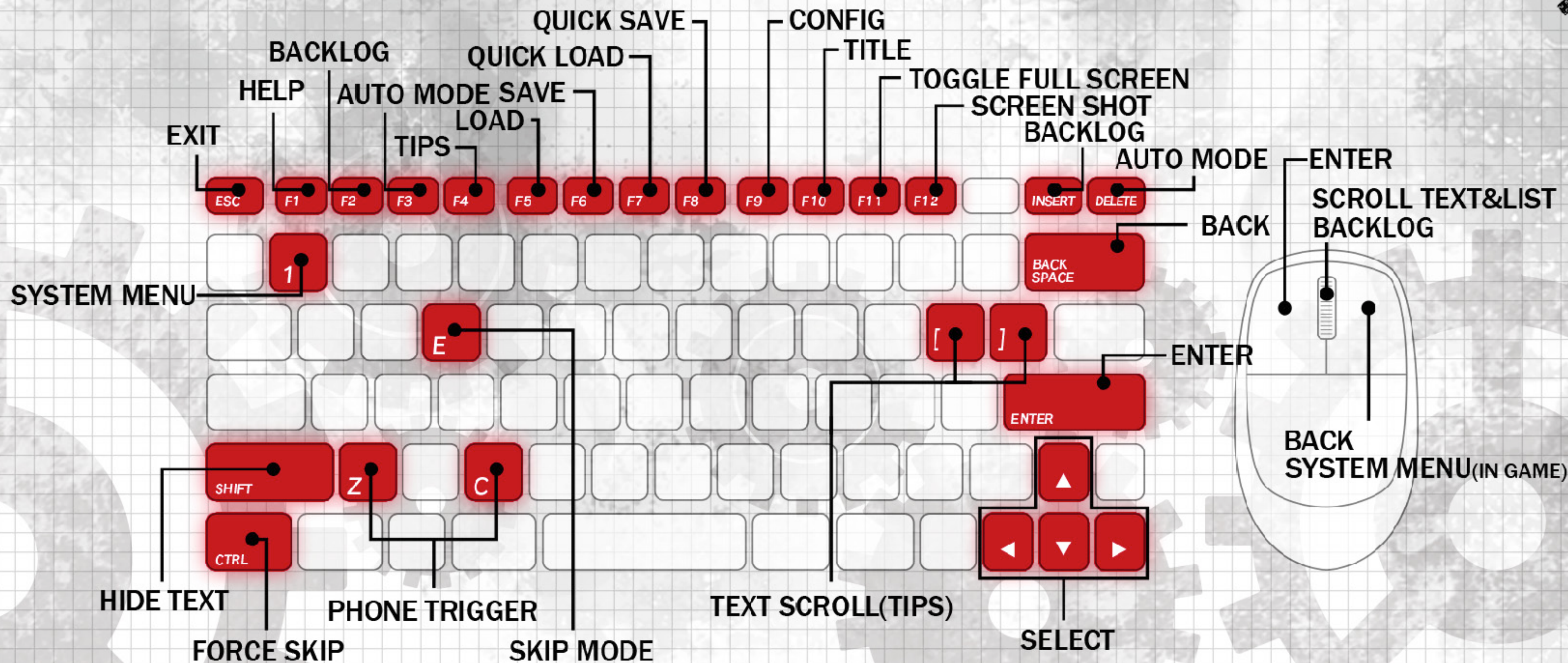
Gamepad Settings

Steins;Gate is an adventure game where you advance the story by reading. The player's intervention can send the story branching in countless numbers of ways. The goal is to observe many different stories, and eventually, to reach the truth.

Title Menu

Move through the menu with the up and down keys, and press ENTER to accept.

START	Starts the story from the beginning.
LOAD ▷QUICK LOAD ▷LOAD	Displays the following submenu. Starts from quick save. (See Page 7) Starts from save. (See Page 7)
EXTRA	You can revisit the images, BGM, etc you've acquired so far in the game. Some modes are not available unless certain conditions are met.
CONFIG	Adjust settings. (See pages 8 & 9)
HELP	Open the HELP menu.

Playing the Game

Advance to the next message by hitting enter.

Display or hide the message window with the SHIFT key.

System Menu

Press the “1” key on the keyboard to open the system menu.
There you can save, load, and adjust settings.

BACK LOG	Reread the story.
QUICK SAVE	Quickly saves the game. (If system data is not saved when you exit the game, your quick save data will be lost.)
QUICK LOAD	Loads the quick save data.
SAVE	Saves your progress.
LOAD	Loads a save.
TIPS LIST	Review various words that appeared in the story.
CONFIG	Adjust game settings.
FULL SCREEN	Switch between window mode and full screen mode.
HELP	Bring up the help menu.
RETURN TITLE	Return to the title screen.
CLOSE MENU	Close the system menu and return to the game.
EXIT GAME	Exit the game.

System Menu



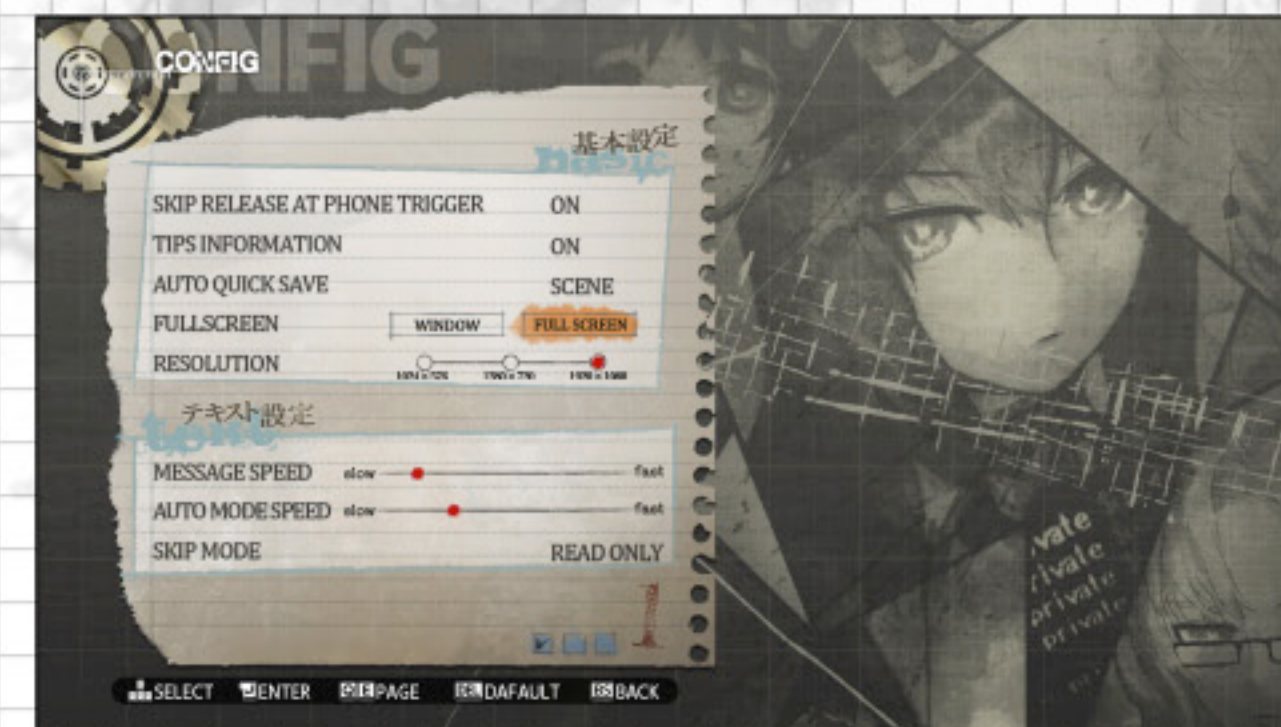
By choosing CONFIG from the title or system menu, you can adjust the game settings.

BASIC SETTINGS

SKIP RELEASE AT PHONE TRIGGER	Choose whether to cancel skip mode when a message arrives on your phone.
TIPS INFORMATION	Display information when a TIPS word appears in the dialogue.
AUTO QUICK SAVE	Adjust the timing of the automatic quick save.
FULLSCREEN	Switch between window mode and full screen mode. Full screen mode resolution is determined by the RESOLUTION option.
RESOLUTION	Change display resolution.

TEXT SETTINGS

MESSAGE SPEED	Set the message display speed.
AUTO MODE WAIT TIME	Set the auto mode speed.
SKIP MODE	Set the skip mode.

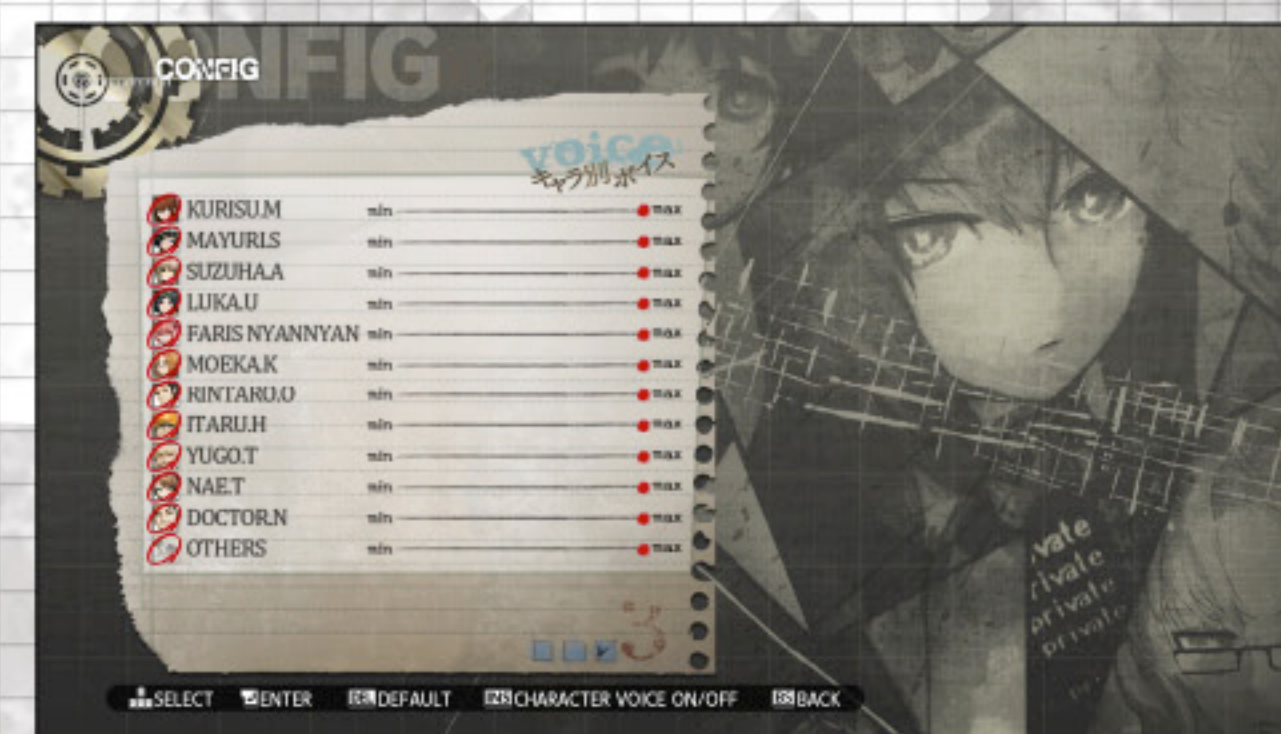
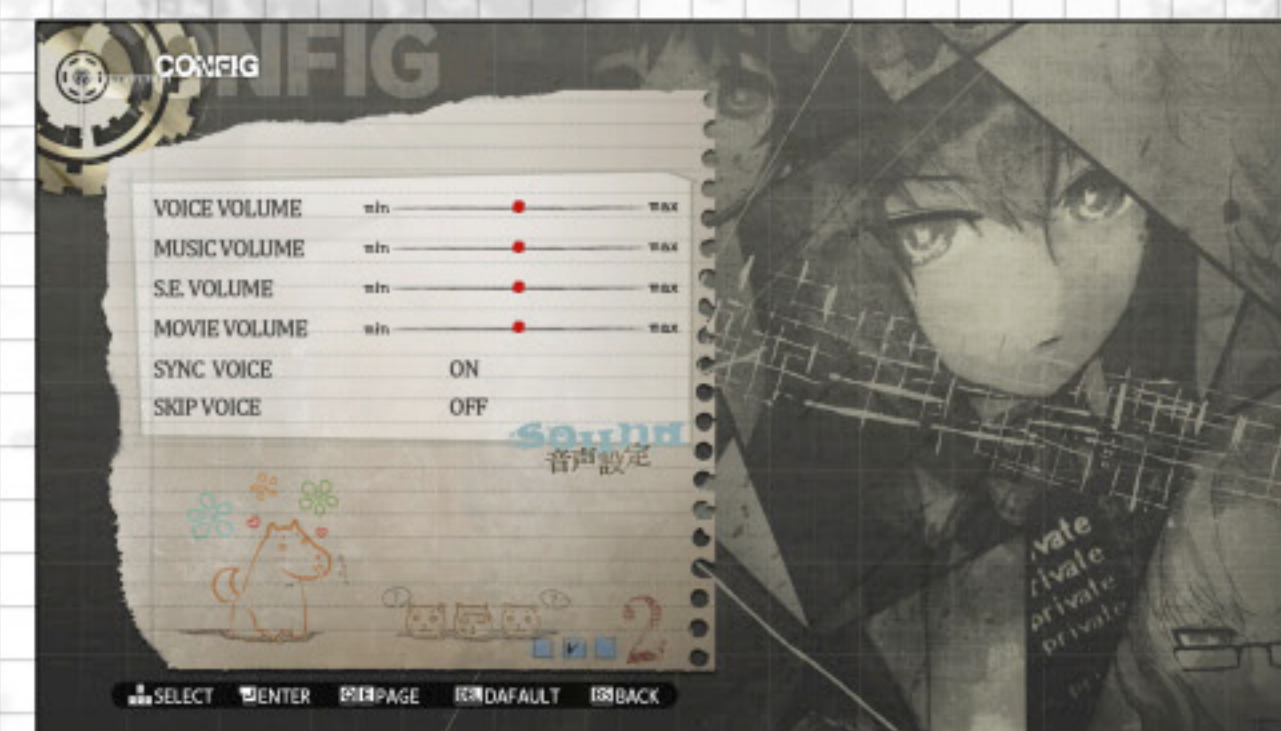


SOUND SETTINGS

VOICE VOLUME	Adjust the voice volume.
BGM VOLUME	Adjust the BGM volume.
S.E. VOLUME	Adjust the SE volume.
MOVIE VOLUME	Adjust the movie volume.
SYNC VOICE	Choose to synchronize display speed with character voices.
SKIP VOICE	Choose to skip voices when a message is skipped.

CHARACTER VOICES

Character voice settings. Change the voice settings for each character.



PHONE TRIGGER

The main character's phone can be called up with the phone trigger ("Z" and "C" on the keyboard.) It can be put away with the BACKSPACE button.

Incoming Call

When a call comes in, you can press the phone trigger button ("Z" or "C" on the keyboard) to call up the main character's cell phone. If the ENTER key is pushed, the call will be answered. You can reject the call by pressing the BACKSPACE key.

Incoming Message

When a message comes in, you can press the phone trigger button ("Z" or "C" on the keyboard) to call up the main character's cell phone. If the ENTER key is pushed, it will move you to the mail box. You can select messages with the cursor keys, and press ENTER to view. When there is a colored word in a message, you can select it and hit ENTER to respond to that message.

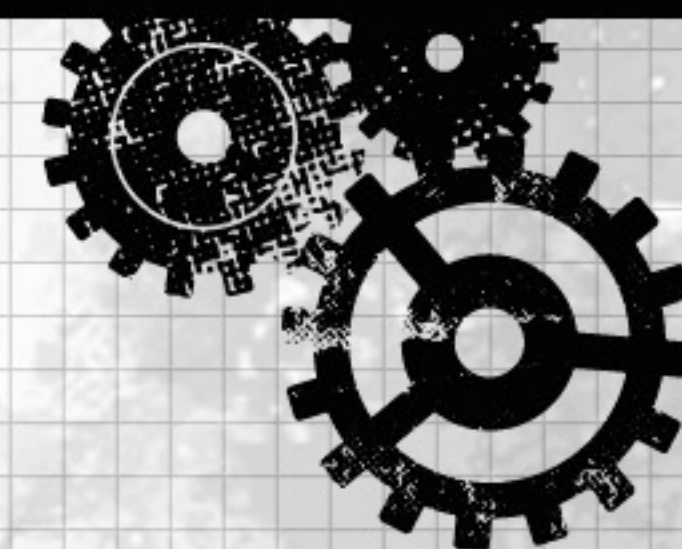
***You can access different functions with the cell phone, even when not on a call.**

Rintaro Okabe

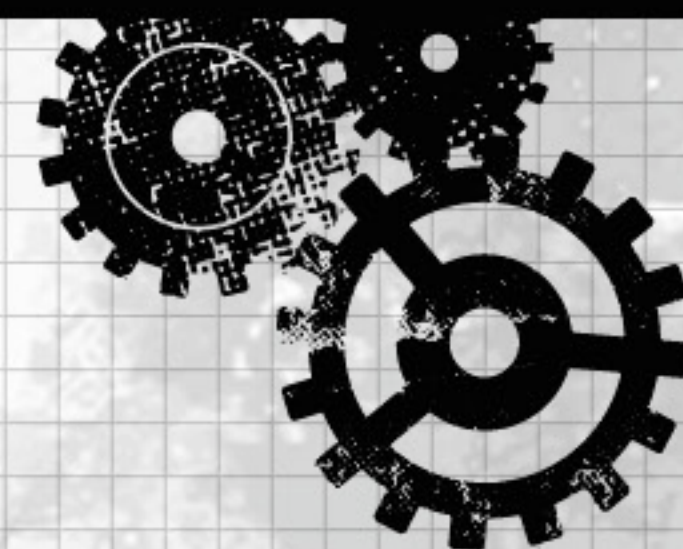
VA. Mamoru Miyano

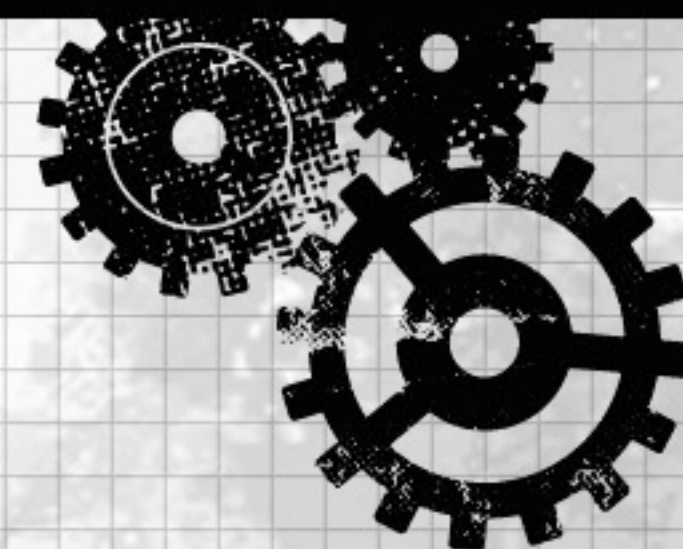
Mayuri Shiina

Suzuha Amāne

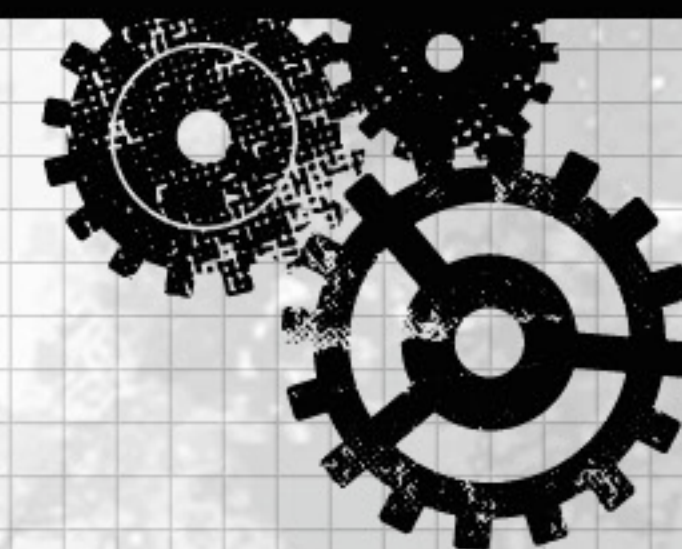
VA: Yukari Tamura
