### When should I arrive?

Volunteer arrival and check-in starts at 7:00 am. Please plan to be checked in and ready to go by 7:45 am.

Team arrival and check-in starts at 8:00 am. Please plan to be set up by 8:30 am.

Spectators and visitors may arrive at any time.

## Team Registration Process

### Before the event

All teams **must complete team registration on the *FIRST* Dashboard and arrive with a printed roster.**

### At the event

The team registration table is located at the top of the main staircase when entering the building.

Only one mentor per team is needed in line for registration. Teams may proceed immediately to the pit area to set up.

You will receive team medals, GF logo gear, and printed event information at registration. Please distribute these items to your team members and mentors at the start of the event.

## Pit Row

The Pit is your home base. Each team will have a table with some space behind. Please keep the area in front of pits clear for travel.

Pit tables will be marked with Team Name and Number. As you set up and personalize your pit, please keep these markers visible to help queueurs find teams.

Pit tables will not have power drops. Four separate charging stations will be available nearby.

Pit Admin will be staffed by volunteers happy to help teams with any questions or needs.

## Queueing

Queueurs will help guide teams to their scheduled events (Robot Game matches and Judging). Please be ready 10 minutes prior to each event start time.

**Robot Game matches:** Queueurs will meet teams at their pit, then proceed via the outside hall to the Robot Game Queueing area..

**Judging:** Queueurs will meet teams at their pit, then proceed to the “Judge Queueing” room at the top of the stairs (see 2<sup>nd</sup> floor map). Teams will wait here until their judging room is ready. Please do not go directly to your judging room (we are trying to keep the halls quiet for presenting teams).

## Judging Rooms

All Judging Rooms are equipped with a TV with HDMI and USB C connections.

Family and friends are allowed to view judging as space allows. There should be no interaction or distraction from spectators. Please silence electronic devices.

## Practice Tables

Robot Game practice tables will be set up for teams and staffed by volunteers. Practice slots are 10 minutes in length. Initial signups should be limited to two slots per team to allow all teams time to prepare.

Teams should check that all game pieces remain at the practice tables and models are reset at the end of their practice slot.

Please do not set up individual challenge mats in traveled pathways. This presents a safety hazard and volunteers will ask teams to remove them.

## Mentor and Peer Awards

Nomination Forms for Mentor and Peer Awards are available and collected at the Pit Admin table. Please consider identifying outstanding candidates for these honors.

## Cafeteria and Food Service

The GlobalFoundries cafeteria is conveniently located in our event space and will have lunch, snacks, and hot and cold drinks available for sale. Additional cash registers and staff are scheduled to minimize wait times.

**You may pack in lunch or snacks for teams.**

## Prayer Room & Quiet Spaces

A prayer room is located on the first floor near the judging rooms. Quiet space rooms are available on the second floor. Both are identified on the attached map and will be indicated with signs.

## Maps, Load-in, and Parking

Follow the LEGO signs!

**Load-in:** Use the circle at the Main Lobby entrance for load-in and drop offs.

**Parking:** Use the event parking at Lot A. Handicapped parking is available in Lot B.

An elevator is available for accessibility as well as team load-in and load-out. It is located to the right of the main stairwell when entering the building.

## Enter: Park Street entrance

### Arrival

1. Teams plan to arrive after 8:00
2. From Interstate 89 to GLOBALFOUNDRIES:
  1. From North or South, take exit 12.
  2. From the North, turn left off exit ramp; from the South, turn right onto Route 2A.
  3. Follow the road through multiple traffic lights, down a hill and over a bridge.
  4. Watch for GLOBALFOUNDRIES entrance signs on the right.
  5. Look for signs LEGO signs to direct you to parking.
